

LA SOUSTO

CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE

RED WINE :
Appellation
Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

Superficie : 11 ha.

Average of the vineyard :
40 to 80 years old.

Production : 6 500 bottles.

Localities : La Crau, le Pied Long, le Bois de la ville, Four à Chaux, le Coteau de l'ange, Palestor.

SOIL : Pebbles on the surface, storing up the heat in the daytime and realising it in the night-time, thus enabling the grapes to attain a high degree of maturity. Sandyred-clay subsoil.

Grape varieties : Grenache 80%, Syrah 10%, Mourvèdre 8%, Counoise 1%, Vaccacère 1%.

Vinification - aging : An average 28 day vatting time. The harvested grapes are stripped from their stems, either partially or totally, according to the vintage. 18 months aging in wooden tun.



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
